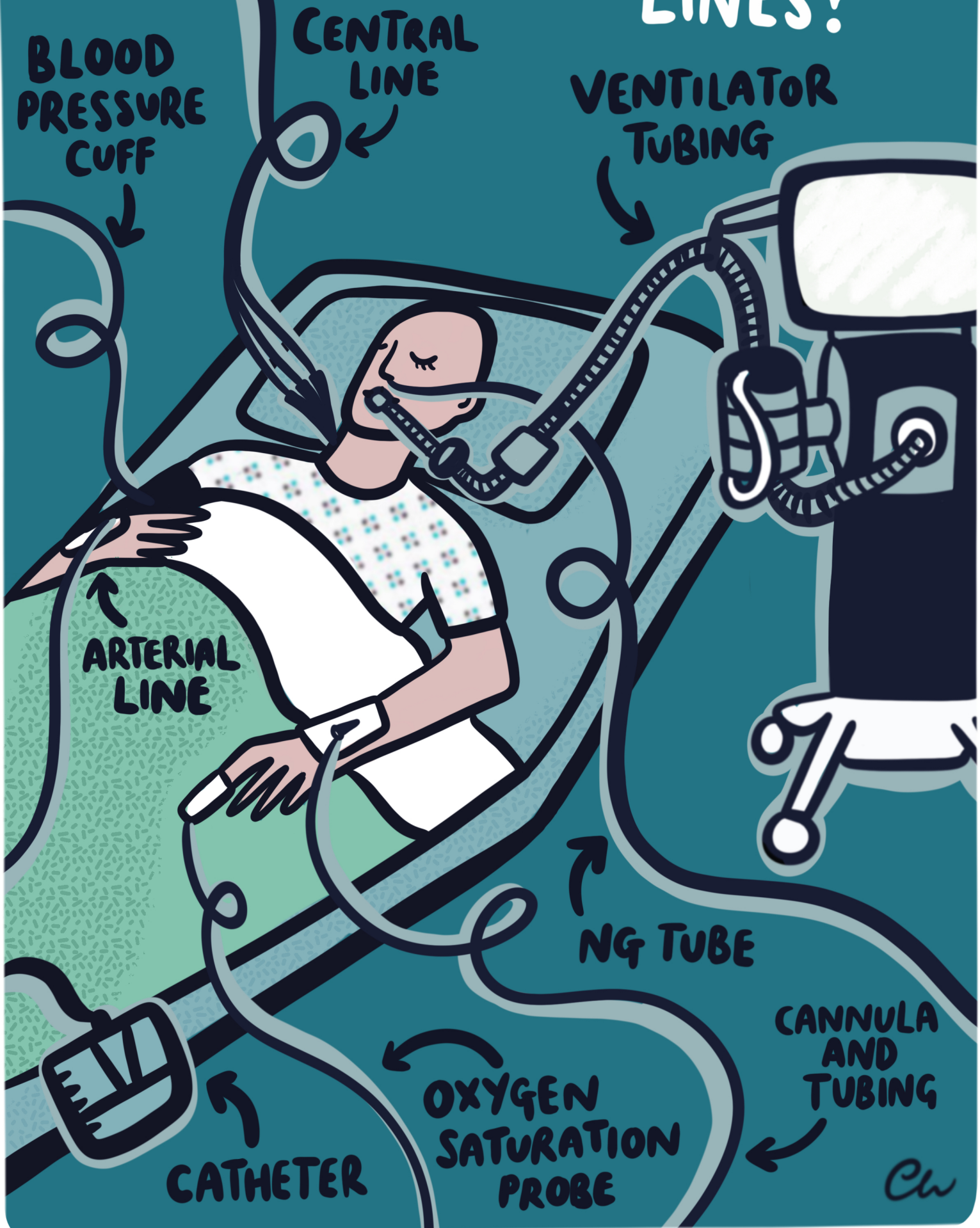


WHAT ARE ALL THE LINES?



WHAT ARE ALL THE LINES?

BLOOD PRESSURE CUFF

A band that tightens on and off around your arm to measure your blood pressure

CENTRAL LINE

A tube in a large vein (usually in your neck) to give medications and fluids

VENTILATOR TUBING

The tubing that attaches you to the machine to support your breathing

NG TUBE (Nasogastric Tube)

A tube from your nose to your stomach for feeding and medications

CANNULA AND TUBING

A tube in a small vein (usually in your hands or arms) to give medications and fluids

OXYGEN SATURATION PROBE

A probe on your finger or ear to measure oxygen levels

CATHETER

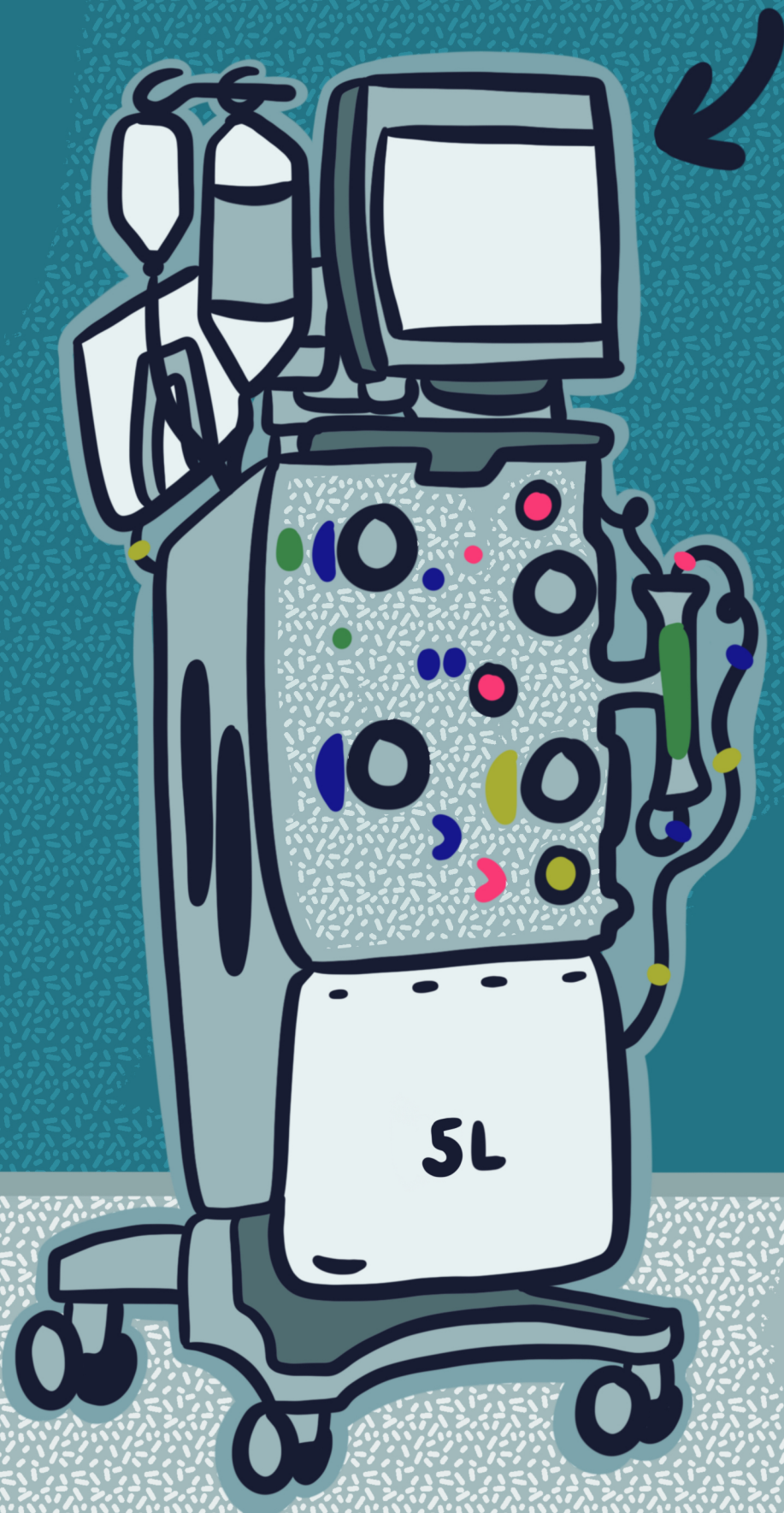
A tube that drains your urine

ARTERIAL LINE

A tube in an artery (usually in your wrist) to monitor blood pressure and take blood from
